- Fire extinguisher
- Manual can opener

- Battery powered radio and NOAA weather radio
- Flashlight
- Batteries
- Toiletries
- Hygiene items
- Moisture wipes
- Sturdy shoes
- Toys, books and games
- Gas or charcoal grill
- Full propane tank/charcoal bags
- Battery-powered lantern

- Gas for a generator
- Propane camp stoves
- Fill vehicle fuel tank
- Cash
- Cell phone and cell phone charger
- Keys

Medicine/First Aid Kit

- Important medications (at least a seven day supply)
- First Aid Kit

Important Documents

(keep all documents in a weatherproof container)

- Insurance policies
- Driver's license
- Wills, deeds, and copies of recent tax returns
- Medical records
- Social Security card
- Birth and Marriage Certificates
- Stocks, bonds and other negotiable contracts
- Written household inventory

- Local emergency phone numbers
- Location of local shelters
- Map of emergency evacuation routes
